**RESOLUTION**

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Michigan State University hereby establishes a fund functioning as an endowment entitled "Judith A. Herrold, Ph.D. Scholarship Fund."

**BACKGROUND**

The initial funding of \$50,000 to establish the "Judith A. Herrold, Ph.D. Scholarship Fund" (the "Fund") will be transferred from the University's restricted gift account. Additional restricted gifts can be added to the Fund.

The spending policy distributions will be used by the Office of Financial Aid to provide scholarships to support students who are pursuing an undergraduate degree in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Education, or Music. Preference will be given to undergraduate students majoring in horticulture, kinesiology, or music. Graduate students enrolled in the College of Education will also be eligible for this award.
