RECOMMENDATION

The Trustee Committee on Budget and Finance recommends that the Board of Trustees establish a fund functioning as an endowment to provide support for the College of Arts and Letters.



RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Michigan State University hereby establishes a fund functioning as an endowment entitled "Stanley and Selma Hollander Artist & Scholar Guest Lecture Series."

BACKGROUND

The initial \$209,058.59 to establish the "Stanley and Selma Hollander Artist & Scholar Guest Lecture Series" (the "Fund") will be transferred from the College of Arts and Letters Dean's discretionary fund. Additional restricted gifts can be added to the Fund.

The spending policy distributions will be used to assist the Department of Art, Art History and Design in the College of Arts and Letters in covering expenses related to bringing visiting artists to campus for interactions with students and the community.

Interim Provost Teresa Sullivan has approved this recommendation from Dr. Christopher P. Long, Dean of the College of Art and Letters.
